igwedge Public Charter schools receive about \$1,000 less per student than your traditional public school.

Public Charter schools also have to pay property taxes on leased buildings.

A Public Charter schools must use classroom dollars because they do not receive funding for school buildings.

Public Charter schools are held to higher accountability standards and face automatic closure, unlike traditional public schools.

Public Charter schools have more than 100,000 students waiting for a seat in a charter school.
