

**High School Open House Curriculum Night**  
**Tuesday 30 August 2016**  
**Plan for the Evening**

**Instructions for night**

- We do not recommend bringing your children. Though High School Open House is not typically as crowded as Middle School Open House, **space in classrooms will probably be limited**. The primary purpose of this night is for parents to get an introduction to High School students' class curriculum. If children are brought, however, they need to **stay with their parents throughout the evening**.
- Park in the main lot between the primary and middle school buildings, or in the student parking lot south of the middle school building. The high school office lot is also available.
- Enter through the Middle Building (new building) lobby entrance. The evening starts in the Middle Building because High School students have lunch in the Middle Building cafeteria, and have classes in both the Middle and High Buildings.
- At 6:00 proceed to your child's 1st period classroom. Class rosters will be posted in the Middle Building lobby, but you can skip these lines by simply asking your child their 1st period class and where that room is.
- 1<sup>st</sup> period teachers will distribute copies of students' schedules to their parents.
- When the program begins, you will get a brief 10-minute presentation on the curriculum and structure of the 1st period class. You will then have a 6-minute passing period (same as the students) to go to the 2nd period class. The room in which each class takes place is noted on the schedule.
- You will follow your child's schedule, periods 1 through 8, with a 10-minute presentation from each.
- Remember that teachers only have 10 minutes to present, and there is only a 6-minute passing period, so you won't have time for substantial one-on-one conversations. Each teacher's room has a conference sign up sheet for those who would like to schedule such a talk.
